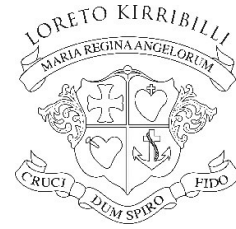

## Information for our Neighbours

As we approach the end of the first school term of 2021, we are pleased to provide you with this project update.

Work on the building phase of the Innovation Centre continues to progress as scheduled.

Concrete slabs have been poured for three levels and the upgrade to the electrical services is ongoing. Activities to the gym extension continue with works to the new foundations now underway.

The on-site team will cease work over the Easter period from 6:00pm Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 until the site reopens on Tuesday, 6<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

When we return from the break, activities will focus on:

- Continuation of concrete pours for the structure
- Commencement of works to the façade and internal services
- Finalising the electrical services upgrade.

As part of the electrical services upgrade, a mobile crane is required to support the installation of infrastructure. Specific dates for this are yet to be confirmed by North Sydney Council, however we expect it to be scheduled in the weeks following Easter. Close neighbours will be advised as soon the information is available. This activity will involve a partial closure of Carabella Street near Parkes Street. Traffic controllers will be onsite at all times to manage safety and enable traffic flow.
